

Light plane crashes in paddock near Goolwa Airport, one dead

One person is dead after a light plane crashed in a paddock near Goolwa Airport, about 70 kilometres south of Adelaide.

The pilot, who was the only occupant in the plane, died at the scene.

It is believed the pilot was taking part in an aerobatics practice session at the time of the crash, which happened about 2:30pm (ACDT).

Police and Emergency Services crews are at the scene.
