

Plane crashes at Northam Airport

A light plane has ended up wedged between two hangars at Northam Airport, east of Perth.

West Australian police said the small aircraft, possibly a Beechcraft plane, hit the hangars at 10.45am and was leaking fuel.

It appeared the pilot was attempting to take off and experienced trouble controlling the aircraft. The plane became wedged between two hangars.

The pilot, a 27-year-old woman, who was the only person on board, has been taken to Northam Hospital by ambulance as a precaution

The area has been evacuated and emergency services are at the scene.

The Australian Transport Safety Bureau said it had been informed of the accident and was gathering information to determine whether an investigation should be launched
