

Plane crash at Luskintyre.

TWO men have suffered non life-threatening injuries after their vintage plane crashed at Luskintyre.

The men, aged 33 and 39, were flown by Hunter Westpac rescue helicopter to John Hunter Hospital.

The plane crashed through a fence about 500 metres south of the Luckintyre airstrip about 1pm.
