

A plane crashed during an aerobatic training, the driver is free from [updated]

The plane of the South African pilot Nigel Hopkins crashed late Sunday afternoon while that he was training for the world championship .

The pilot, who managed to extract the device with its parachute is unharmed.

One of the plane's wings broke off during flight for reasons that remain undetermined. The aircraft came to rest in a field near the airport.

According to the French Federation aviation, it is "a very rare accident." The gendarmerie brigade of air transport should go on Monday on the accident scene.

Nigel Hopkins was training this weekend on Serruelles Airfield with British pilots for the world championship to be held from Thursday in Châteauroux (Indre).

The office of investigation and analysis, civil aviation and the gendarmerie brigade of air transport were on hand Monday morning. They proceeded to hear the driver.

In the afternoon, the investigation continued in the field next to the airfield where the plane crashed to retrieve debris from the machine.
