Collision with terrain, involving a SkyJib 3 RPA, near Melbourne Cricket Ground, Victoria, on 29 March 2015

Investigation status: Active

Summary

The ATSB has commenced an investigation into an incident involving a SkyJib 3 remotely piloted aircraft (RPA), near the Melbourne Cricket Ground, Victoria, on 29 March 2015.

The RPA collided with terrain during aerial photography operations. There were no injuries or damage to property, but the RPA was substantially damaged.

As part of the investigation, the ATSB will seek additional information from the RPA operator.

A report will be released within several months.
