Civil Aviation Safety Authority confirms Cessna crash landing on Elcho Island

AVIATION authorities are investigating the emergency landing of a small plane in the north eastern Northern Territory.

The plane landed without its landing gear at Galiwinku on Elcho Island just before 12pm today.

A spokesman from the Civil Aviation Safety Association confirmed a Cessna 172R aircraft VH-HTP had a wheels up landing at Elcho Island.

"It was on a private hire. Australian Transport Safety Bureau also informed," the spokesman said.

The two passengers and pilot escaped the crash unharmed.
