

## Pilot escapes serious injury after light plane crash in Port Lincoln

A pilot has escaped serious injury after crash landing his single-seat plane at Port Lincoln, on South Australia's west coast.

The crash happened about 11:20am at the Port Lincoln Airfield.

The pilot was assessed by paramedics and is not believed to have any serious injuries.

The Australian Transport Safety Bureau (ATSB) is investigating the crash.

It is the second light plane crash in South Australia this month.

A Cessna plane carrying skydivers was forced to make an emergency landing in Victoria Park in Adelaide's CBD on October 2.

Two of the skydivers were taken to the Royal Adelaide Hospital with minor injuries.
