Update: Reports of plane crash - Wollongong

A search will continue tomorrow morning following reports of a plane crash in Wollongong tonight.

About 7.45pm (Tuesday 27 January 2015), officers attached to Wollongong Local Area Command received reports of a loud bang overhead between Bulli Tops and Sublime Point.

Officers attached to Fire & Rescue NSW, Police Rescue and NSW Ambulance Paramedics commenced a wide-scale search of the area.

While nothing has been found at this point, police have received reports of a missing single-seater aircraft, with one man on board, after it left Wedderburn Airport today.

A foot and air search of the area will continue over the next few hours, and will recommence at first light, around 6am, tomorrow morning (Wednesday 28 January 2015).

A command post has been set up at Sublime Point Lookout. No further details are known at this time.
