

Pilot unhurt in Morawa plane crash

A Geraldton pilot was lucky to escape injury after his ultralight aircraft crashed into the ground at Morawa, in the State's Mid West.

The 80-year-old pilot was flying from Geraldton to Morawa when the aircraft was caught in a cross-wind on approach to the Morawa Airport about 3.30pm today.

The aircraft sustained damage to its propeller and undercarriage, but the pilot was not injured.

The Australian Transport Safety Bureau was notified of the incident.
