

Passengers lucky to escape serious injury after plane rollover

UPDATE 5PM:

A MALE in his 60s has been taken to Nambour Hospital in a stable condition with minor injuries after an earlier aircraft incident at Cootharaba.

The two other passengers that were in the plane when it flipped did not require treatment.

UPDATE 4.10PM:

THE three occupants of the aircraft that has rolled at Cootharaba have managed to walk away without serious injury.

A QAS spokesman said that all three patients that were in the plane when it rolled were out and walking around with only minor injuries.

It is believed that the crash occurred during landing after a wheel collapsed, flipping the aircraft.

EARLIER:

PARAMEDICS and fire crews are currently on there way to Greenfields Lane in Cootharaba where it's reported that an aircraft has rolled
