

# Pilot injured in crop duster plane crash north of Esperance

The pilot of a crop dusting plane has been flown to Perth with critical injuries after his aircraft crashed. Police say the plane came down about 105km north of Esperance just before 10am on Saturday.



The pilot was seriously injured in the crash but managed to free himself from the wreckage.

Emergency services were called to the scene and the pilot was put on board a Royal Flying Doctor Aircraft for the flight to Jandakot and on to Royal Perth Hospital.

Update: 15:04 - The pilot is reported to be a 29-year-old from Victoria. He is in a stable condition in hospital and his injuries are not thought to be life threatening.
