

Landing fault causes Vic light plane crash

Emergency services flooded onto the tarmac of a Melbourne airport after a light plane crashed on landing.

Two men have walked away from a light plane which crashed while landing at Melbourne's Moorabbin airport. The two-seater aircraft experienced a mechanical fault while landing at about 10am on Tuesday with emergency services quickly rushing out on to the runway.

The two men onboard were uninjured in the crash which is thought to have been caused by a failure of the nose wheel, a Metropolitan Fire Brigade spokeswoman said.
