

Two people dead after 'aviation incident' near Dalby

Two people have died after their glider crashed near Dalby this morning.

The glider reportedly lost control while trying to land just before 10am at Bowenville, a Queensland Ambulance spokesman said.

Earlier paramedics had been treating two people at the scene, the QAS spokesman said, and they were in a critical condition.

Firefighters, police and paramedics were called to the scene at Mason Road, Bowenville about 9.50am.

A Queensland Fire and Emergency Service spokeswoman said two crews were at the scene assisting.
