

Man tells of moment plane came down

UPDATE 2PM: TERRY Adams was at work when he got the call telling him a plane had crashed into his home.

When he arrived at his Pacific Haven Crt home and saw the wreck, his first thought was 'is the bloke dead or alive?' Thankfully the 68-year-old pilot escaped the ultra-light aircraft wreckage with minor injuries.

"I'm glad he's not dead," Mr Adams said. "The house, it doesn't matter. "That's what insurance is for; s*** happens." No one was home when the plane came down about 11.15am.

The one-seater aircraft caused damage to the interior and exterior of the home.

Mr Adams has lived at the address for 15 years, and was also home when two people died in an ultra-light plane at Pacific Haven in 2015.

UPDATE 12.34PM: Emergency services have confirmed that a man has been taken to Hervey Bay Hospital in a stable condition following this morning's aircraft incident.
