

Two people die in gyrocopter crash south of Orange, NSW

Two people have died after a gyrocopter crashed south of Orange in central west New South Wales.

Police were called to a paddock on Forest Road, Spring Hill, shortly after 12:00pm (AEDT).

Both victims are males but it is too early to determine their identities.

There were no other passengers.

Fire crews assisted in putting out a small fire following the crash, which has now been extinguished.

The nearest airport is 1 kilometre from the crash site.

Police, with assistance from the Australian Sports Rotorcraft Association, will investigate the cause of the crash.

A report will be prepared for the Coroner.
