

Two men have died in one of two Sunday morning plane crashes in Queensland

A pilot and his passenger were killed this morning when a light plane crashed in bushland while another person survived a separate crash about an hour later.

Two men have been killed in a light plane crash at a property in central Queensland.

Police were called to the Round Hill Rd property at Captain Creek, near Agnes Waters south of Gladstone, around 7am on Sunday.

It is unclear what caused the plane to come down but the two men died at the scene.

Forensic Crash Unit officers are investigating and will prepare a report for the coroner.

Another patient was taken to hospital on Sunday morning before paramedics arrived, after a light plane crash in the Atherton Tablelands in Far North Queensland.

The aircraft was found on its side at the Atherton Aerodrome, according to the Cairns Post.
