Light plane crashes in failed take-off at Archerfield Airport

A light plane has crashed during take-off at Archerfield Airport on Brisbane's southside.



Emergency services were called to the airport off Beatty Road about 11.15am.

The result of the aborted take-off at Archerfield Airport on Wednesday morning.

Archerfield Airport general manager Heather Mattes said it was "an aborted take-off" and while there was some fuel leakage from the aircraft, but the male pilot was unharmed.

A fire service spokeswoman said the aircraft crashed into a ditch, three crews arrived and dealt with the fuel leakage.

The Queensland Ambulance Service said the pilot, who was the aircraft's sole occupant, got himself out of the aircraft and had not suffered any serious injuries.
