

Pilot in serious condition after plane crash landed at Melbourne airport

A pilot has been rushed to hospital after becoming trapped in a light plane when he crash landed upside down at an airport in Melbourne.

A man has been rushed to hospital after crash landing a light plane at an airport in Melbourne's southeast and becoming trapped.

Emergency services were called to Moorabbin just before 10am following reports an aircraft had crashed at the airport.

"Paramedics treated a man believed to be in his 20s for head and lower body injuries," a spokesperson for Ambulance Victoria said.

"He has been taken by road ambulance to The Alfred Hospital in a serious condition."

It is understood the man was the pilot of the plane and became trapped inside the aircraft after the crash.

"The exact circumstances surrounding the crash are still to be determined," Victoria Police said in a statement. "The Australian Transport Safety Bureau and Civil Aviation Safety Authority will be notified of the crash." The light plane is believed to have been on a training flight when the crash occurred, according to <u>Nine</u>. Photos from the scene shows the yellow plane upside down with emergency service crews surrounding it.
