Pilot hurt after wind flips plane at Aldinga Airfield

• A pilot has escaped serious injury after his plane flipped while taxiing at a southern suburbs aerodrome.

Emergency services were called to the Aldinga Airfield just after 3.30pm on Saturday after receiving reports of a light aircraft on its side.

The aircraft is understood to have been taxiing on the runway when a gust of wind flipped the plane.

The 25-year-old male pilot crawled from the plane and was treated by paramedics for an injured shoulder.
