Two people have had an incredibly lucky escape after their light plane crashed in Victoria.

The plane was left dangling upside down in trees in Hunterston, east of Melbourne.

Remarkably a man in his 70s, who is believed to be the pilot, and a teenage male were out and walking around by the time emergency arrived on scene.

The man suffered injuries to his back and chest and was airlifted to the Alfred Hospital.

His condition deteriorated after the crash and he's currently in a serious but stable condition.

The teen suffered minor scratches and was taken to Traralgon Hospital.

The cause of the crash is still unclear.
