Patient in serious condition after Scenic Rim plane crash

A man in his mid-60s has suffered serious spine and head injuries in a reported light aircraft incident near Aratula in the Scenic Rim.

A Queensland Ambulance Service spokeswoman said paramedics were called at 9.51am for a reported plane incident near Tarome Road.

By 11am a rescue helicopter and critical-care paramedics had arrived at the scene.

The man, who was in a serious but stable condition, was airlifted to the Princess Alexandra Hospital before midday.
