Hello and welcome to another Issue of the AirCentre News Flash from the News desk at Archerfield airport where aviation history is recorded for all those persons who are interested in, pilot, or enjoy the ownership of light aircraft.

This Issue is released to advise readers that Week Three news is now on the server and covers such recent items as the C182 Cooktown accident, what not to do if you intend to join the "Mile High Club", an Italian "Air Argument" and other interesting topics and to advise you about the recent format changes to the News Page.

There is also a small problem with the latest virus getting about the Internet that needs a mention.

Called "Code Red" it has affected public access of the AirCentre PC and especially for those of you interested in the "Breaking News" area.

This Red virus has not affected the News Desk PC (W95 O/S) as such but with all the filters applied by the various servers to combat the bug it now seems that there will be a permanent slowing down of data travelling around the 'net.

These filters have also affected the direct accessibility of the cable modem based News Desk PC via the server network which I think is best left as is.

The virus travels back and forth trying to enter this PC from various other "servers" up to about 100 times a day (each attack creates a log) with these "servers" appearing not to have the necessary software on hand to stop the bug.

There is a strong possibility that they may be unaware of the "travelling bug" coming from their system.

So to enable dedicated readers of the AirCentre "breaking news" area to catch up on the latest as it happens, the applicable news files will be up-loaded to the public server on a regular basis during the week and will (should) be accessible at the following address: -

For those of you who normally view on a weekly basis, the old "./news/index.htm" page has had an upgrade and will not display now as intended (frameset stuff).

The displayed page includes a "header" that has up to four (by week four) "clickable" macromedia image files that may require a flash "plug-in" to your browser.

Just as a matter of interest, there has been a few (only 2 really) "complaints" received on the new format and if this new set-up is not satisfactory to all readers then I will revert back to the "old" non

flash but "JavaScript" based system.
